Environmental

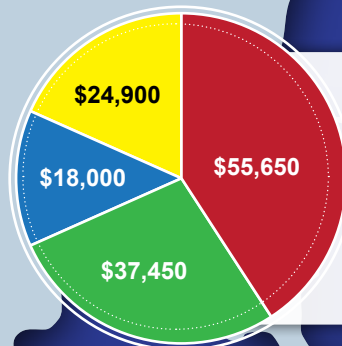
Water quality monitoring.
